



News for AAUW State Liaison Session. On May 27, I was able to join 15 other state leaders as we had some time with Malinda Gaul, our board member liaison. <u>Update on the Open Membership Vote</u>: The Open Membership Bylaw proposal did not pass. It was a close vote with 64%-65% of the members in favor, but it missed the 66.7% level needed for adoption. The new AAUW national board president was on the Zoom meeting. She indicated that this next year is a critical time for AAUW national planning and how state and branches can engage with their communities. It is clear that young women are not as inclined to join an organization unless they can find value and a clear identify with their avocacy efforts.
